Format Individual Stroke play (Best nett result only)

Prizes Less than 10 players – 1st Only
10 – 20 players – Top 2 places
Over 20 players – Top 3 places

The midweek member with the best nett result on the day will gain free access to the next possible weekend Order of Merit event. Should they not be able to participate the access would be passed on to the next best midweek member nett result.
*cannot be transferred to a different month or another Member.

Course Condition Help us keep the course in outstanding condition by repairing your pitch marks, raking bunkers and filling in your divots.

OOM There will be 7 midweek medal in which you would need to have played in a minimum of 5 in order to qualify for the midweek medal order of merit. Order of merit points will be allocated as follows for each roll up.

First place – 5 Points
Second Place – 4 Points
Third Place – 3 Points
Fourth Place – 2 Points
Fifth Place – 1 Point

Players with the most order of merit points after meeting the above requirements will receive a set of Irons **Sponsored by Reza Hygiene**

Countback Rounds - For each individual round countback will be based on the last 9,6,3 and 1 holes of the course.
Order of Merit - Countback will be based on the players last 18 holes in the series

Scoring On the completion of your round please return your scorecards to the golf shop. Scorecard must be marked & signed by another official handicapped member.
*Scorecards not entered into the handicap monitor and not returned to the golf shop will be immediately disqualified.
